Every other day a home health provider is facing an audit, investigation or survey by the OMIG, OIG or DOH. Whistleblowers are becoming overnight millionaires by filing complaints against their current or former employers. Technical requirements are the basis for overpayments to Medicare and Medicaid. This two-part webinar (in 90 minute sessions) will examine specific clinical, billing, marketing, referral, inducement and cost report issues being targeted. Areas to be covered include:

- OIG 31 Risk Areas
- OMIG Audit Issues for CHHAs and LTHHCPs
- OMIG Workplan
- OIG Workplan and Fraud Alerts
- TPL Audits; role of ABNs and Demand Billing
- RAC Home Health Issues

Compliance strategies to meet the challenges of the issues being examined, and the requirements of the mandatory OMIG Compliance Plan will be presented. The new provisions of federal and state False Claims Acts, which stress enforcement actions, will also be discussed.

Who should participate in the call: Compliance Officers, management and staff who deal with clinical, financial, billing, marketing and operational matters, as well as supervisors who can train additional staff on these issue.

The reason to participate is to learn the issues impacting the industry so you can conduct an internal review of your agency, with the assistance of health care counsel, to identify any non-compliance that requires immediate correction and future training.
